Event Rules

- Sights, trigger releases, and stabilizers allowed (not required). No crossbows.
- Arm guards required for all archers (we have some to borrow).
- Finger tabs/gloves required for those without trigger releases (We have some to borrow).
- Attendees do not need their own equipment. We have recurve bows (14#, 24#, 30#: left and right) and arrows to borrow.
- Attendees may use their personal or club bows provided they pass inspection by an On Target Archery Leader and are less than 35 lbs. draw.
- No open-toed shoes or cell phones on the range.
- Individual club members may attend.
