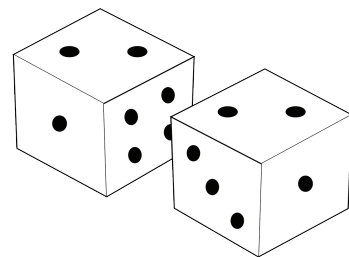


4-H GAME DESIGN CHALLENGE

PART 2 Due June 30th

Using cardboard, cardstock or other materials, begin to design your game. Don't forget to have people test your game so you can make improvements!



PART 3 Due July 31st

To Market, To Market...

Now it is time to make your final product! You will be sent supplies. Take everything you learned from each iteration and create your final game!
