These pictures will be used in the Fashion design Contest Power point at the spring NJDAR awards luncheon/dinner. Your contest entry indicates that NJDAR is permitted to use your images in this show. This is the only purpose for these images and will not appear anywhere else. DO NOT SEND PRINTED PHOTOS. Identify your pictures like this:
